

BRIDGE CREEK RANCH

This Brazos Valley ranch has all the elements to make a great recreational property or country showplace—easy access, rolling topography, a mix of bucolic pastures and thick post oak woods, and great water features. All in a very desirable location with excellent neighbors and great proximity to College Station, historic Washington County, Lake Somerville, and Round Top.

Price: \$1,400,000 (\$7,000/acre)



Location: Located just 7 miles from Lake Somerville and 20 miles from Kyle Field, approximate driving distances are 100 miles from the downtowns of Houston and Austin. The entry fronts FM 1361.

Habitat: Approximately 50 acres of rolling pastures are irregularly shaped around the main lake and a draw, scenically interspersed with huge hardwoods, the main lake, and pockets of timber and underbrush. The balance of the ranch is a buffer of thick Post Oak Savanah woods loaded with post oaks and other typical species including burr, blackjack, and water oaks, ash, and hackberry. Largely untouched, a thick understory of yaupon, beauty berry, and scattered juniper provide great cover and browse for game.

The topography is gently rolling with approximately 50 feet of relief between the draws and hills, with elevations ranging from ± 270 -320'. Seasonal Bridge Creek crosses through the wooded portion of the property.

FEMA maps indicate most of the ranch is outside the 100 year flood plain, with the area along the creek and feeder draws the exception.

Water: The ranch features lakes of ± 3 and ± 2 acres. The larger lake provides a signature entry near the front gate, while the smaller lake is secluded in the wooded portion of the ranch.



Wildlife: Primary game includes whitetail deer, hogs, dove, and ducks. The lakes are prime for stocking, and there are some existing bass.

Minerals: Surface only. The property is not leased and there is no active or known past drilling activity.

Information About Brokerage Services

Texas law requires all real estate license holders to give the following information about brokerage services to prospective buyers, tenants, sellers and landlords.

TYPES OF REAL ESTATE LICENSE HOLDERS:

- A BROKER is responsible for all brokerage activities, including acts performed by sales agents sponsored by the broker.
- A SALES AGENT must be supervised by a broker to perform any services and works with clients on behalf of the broker.

A BROKER'S MINIMUM DUTIES REQUIRED BY LAW (A client is the person or party that the broker represents):

- Put the interests of the client above all others, including the broker's own interests;
- Inform the client of any material information about the property or transaction received by the broker;
- Answer the client's questions and present any offer to or counter-offer from the client; and
- Treat all parties to a real estate transaction honestly and fairly.

A LICENSE HOLDER CAN REPRESENT A PARTY IN A REAL ESTATE TRANSACTION:

- AS AGENT OR SUBAGENT FOR OWNER (SELLER/LANDLORD): The broker becomes the property owner's agent through an agreement with the owner, usually in a written listing to sell or property management agreement. A subagent represents the owner, not the buyer, through an agreement with the owner's broker. An owner's agent must perform the broker's minimum duties above and must inform the owner of any material information about the property or transaction known by the agent, including information disclosed to the agent or subagent by the buyer or buyer's agent.
- AS AGENT FOR BUYER/TENANT: The broker becomes the buyer/tenant's agent by agreeing to represent the buyer, usually through a written representation agreement. A buyer's agent must perform the broker's minimum duties above and must inform the buyer of any material information about the property or transaction known by the agent, including information disclosed to the agent by the seller or seller's agent.
- **AS AGENT FOR BOTH INTERMEDIARY**: To act as an intermediary between the parties the broker must first obtain the written agreement of *each party* to the transaction. The written agreement must state who will pay the broker and, in conspicuous bold or underlined print, set forth the broker's obligations as an intermediary. A broker who acts as an intermediary:
- Must treat all parties to the transaction impartially and fairly;
- May, with the parties' written consent, appoint a different license holder associated with the broker to each party (owner and buyer) to communicate with, provide opinions and advice to, and carry out the instructions of each party to the transaction.
- Must not, unless specifically authorized in writing to do so by the party, disclose:
 - o that the owner will accept a price less than the written asking price;
 - o that the buyer/tenant will pay a price greater than the price submitted in a written offer; and
 - o any confidential information or any other information that a party specifically instructs the broker in writing not to disclose, unless required to do so by law.

TO AVOID DISPUTES, ALL AGREEMENTS BETWEEN YOU AND A BROKER SHOULD BE IN WRITING AND CLEARLY ESTABLISH:

- The broker's duties and responsibilities to you, and your obligations under the representation agreement.
- Who will pay the broker for services provided to you, when payment will be made and how the payment will be calculated.
